This essential position is responsible for the provision of spiritual care services to Home-Based AIM patients and caregivers, either directly or through coordination of care with other spiritual counselors. Duties include:

- Evaluating patients and developing a quality plan of care to meet the needs of the patients/caregivers who request spiritual care services
- Completing timely spiritual assessments
- Providing direct spiritual care
- Serving as a liaison between patients/caregivers and community chaplains/spiritual counselors
- Officiating at funeral or memorial services
- Completing medical record documentation

Requirements for this position include:

- Graduate of an accredited seminary or school of theology (BD, M.Div., or equivalent theological degree)
- Completion of at least one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE)
- Experience with issues concerning the terminally ill and death and dying
- Maintains a valid MI Driver's license and has the availability of a reliable, licensed, and insured vehicle for use on the job
- Presents a negative TB skin test and/or chest x-ray
