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The place for good days! Our Adult Day Services program is seeking a compassionate and energetic per diem (PRN) **Program Assistant**. Adult Day Services provides professional care for older adults who need assistance during the week day and is located in our Portage, MI Oakland Centre. Program Assistants provide social and health-related services for our guests Monday through Friday (no weekends or holidays).

Responsibilities include:

- Assisting in the planning and implementation of appropriate social and therapeutic activities for participants on a day-to-day basis.
- Performing personal care (i.e. bathing, toileting, etc.) and attending to participant requests promptly.
- Assisting with ambulation and exercise as directed by the Program Manager, RN, or Therapist.
- Documenting and discussing participant responses, reactions, and participation in activities with the Interdisciplinary Team Members.
- Ensuring a safe environment for guests.

Requirements for the position include:

- High school graduate or equivalent.
- Maintains license as a Certified Nurse's Aide from the State of Michigan.
- Maintains current BLS certification.
- Minimum of one year experience providing direct care.
- Ability to work effectively with patients of various ages, mental competence, and physical disabilities.
- Previous activity experience working with the elderly or persons with dementia and/or disabilities preferred.
