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Hospice Care of Southwest Michigan is seeking a **Registered Nurse** to join our first shift Adult Day Program team on a PRN basis. The Adult Day Program is based at our Oakland Centre in Portage, MI.

### Primary Duties:

- Provides daily nursing care to participants—implements, directs, supervises, and evaluates all clinical care rendered to the client.
- Performs the initial clinical assessment and evaluation of participants. Develops the initial plan of care in consultation with other team members and physician, which is then reviewed every 30 days. Revises plan of care as necessary in consultation with other Adult Day staff, the staff of other involved agencies, and the physician. Responsible for notifying physician, family member, the Director and appropriate staff of any changes.
- Provides ongoing assessment of the health needs of current participants as requested through routine monitoring of vital signs, symptoms, medication compliance, and communication with physicians, family, and caretakers.
- Coordinates with the Program Manager and Assistants in planning and implementing all activities of the Center. Participates in structured activities planned for participants.
- Teaches, supervises, and counsels the participant and family members regarding nursing and personal care needs and other related problems of the client.
- Coordinates with contracted agencies that provide specialized therapy (OT, PT, ST). Instructs and supervises Program Assistants in provision of these services.
- Assists with food preparation and housekeeping to provide a quality environment of care for the client.
- Coordinates all the activities and paperwork involved in discharging a client, including coordinating with other care providers/facilities and summarizing discharge notes and instructions.

### Additional requirements for this position include:

- Graduate of an accredited school of professional nursing (BSN preferred).
- Maintains license, in good standing, as a Registered Nurse from the State of Michigan.
- Maintains current BLS certification.
- A minimum of one year's general nursing experience is required with current medical, surgical, or gerontology experience preferred.

- Ability to work effectively with participants of various ages, mental competence, and physical disabilities.
- Maintains a valid Michigan driver's license and has the availability of a reliable, licensed and insured vehicle for use on the job.

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
